### AMENDMENT TO THE PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF WYNDTREE, TRINITY OAKS, CHELSEA PLACE, THOUSAND OAKS, THOUSAND OAKS EAST, THE VILLAGES AT FOX HOLLOW, FOXWOOD, LAUREL GREEN, CHAMPIONS' CLUB, FOX HOLLOW AND HERTIAGE SPRINGS COMMUNITIES, BUSINESSES AND OFFICES AT THE TRINITY TOWN CENTER, TRINITY ARTS MEDICAL CENTER, TRINITY OUTPATIENT CENTER, SEVEN SPRINGS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, SEVEN SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL AND TRINITY OAKS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

THE FGUA HAS AMENDED THE PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE ISSUED DUE TO A FIRE LINE BREAK LOCATED AT THE TRINITY TOWN CENTER AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF TRINITY BOULEVARD AND LITTLE ROAD, WHICH CAUSED A TEMPORARY LOSS OF WATER PRESSURE EXPERIENCED IN THE FGUA PASCO UTILITY SYSTEM.

THE BOIL WATER NOTICE HAS BEEN LIFTED FOR RESIDENTS OF WYNDTREE, CHELSEA PLACE, THE VILLAGES AT FOX HOLLOW, LAUREL GREEN, CHAMPIONS' CLUB AND HERITAGE SPRINGS COMMUNITIES, AS THE WATER PRESSURE REMAINED ABOVE SATISFACTORY LEVELS DURING AND AFTER THE WATER LINE BREAK. CUSTOMERS MAY RESUME THEIR WATER USE AT THEIR DISCRETION.

AS A PRECAUTION, REMAINING COMMUNITIES AFFECTED BY THE PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE SHOULD CONTINUE BOILING WATER USED FOR DRINKING OR COOKING. A ROLLING BOIL OF ONE MINUTE IS SUFFICIENT. AS AN ALTERNATIVE, BOTTLED WATER MAY BE USED.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK. A BOIL WATER RESCISSION NOTICE WILL BE DISTRIBUTED PENDING THE SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF THE SURVEY.
